### **SATURDAY**                      **SPLIT – OMIŠ**

Departure from Split harbour at 14:00, cruising along the Dalmatian coast toward Makarska Riviera. After the afternoon bathing at one of the most beautiful beaches of this coast or rafting along the Cetina river canyon (not included in the total price), continue the journey to Omiš, a picturesque town between steep mountain cliffs, through which the Cetina river for centuries has found its way to the sea. Visiting this town you will find many churches and other cultural and historical beauties.

### **SUNDAY**                              **OMIŠ – KORČULA**

Early in the morning we continue the trip toward Korčula, the birthplace of the famous explorer and adventurer Marco Polo. Upon arriving in Korčula you will be left to your own instincts and explore the old Korčula, situated in this peninsula, where separated, it defies the impact of the new, modern world. The island and the town of Korčula hide so many legends, stories and monuments, more than anywhere else. Listen to the stories of stone walls having been carefully collected and kept for more than two centuries? Overnight stay in the port of Korčula.

### **MONDAY**                              **KORČULA – LASTOVO**

After a short morning walk through the town market, we continue our trip toward Lastovo, an old former imperial Roman island, with the most remote inhabited Dalmatians. Anchored in the Ubli harbor, you will have the opportunity to discover an untouched nature, dense and wild forests of the island. Lastovo is surrounded by numerous smaller islands, with bays suitable for diving; it is also known for its small churches and unusual chimneys.

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## **TUESDAY                      LASTOVO – RAVNIK (Green cave) – KOMIŽA / VIS**

Early in the morning we continue sailing towards the island of Vis which, due to its unique geographical position, was a strategic naval port, and was closed to tourists for long period of time. Because of this isolation, Vis has a special charm, where you can experience “Mediterranean as it once was”. In the vicinity of Vis island, there is the islet Ravnik, with the famous Green Cave, where we make a break for a morning swim. In the afternoon we sail to the town of Komiža and Vis, to stay overnight. Fishing of the eastern Adriatic started in the town of Komiža. Along the entire east side of the bay in Komiža, there are many water springs. The town of Vis developed on the north side of the island, in the vicinity of the remains of the ancient Issa, IV century BC.

## **WEDNESDAY                KOMIŽA /VIS – BIŠEVO (Blue cave) – HVAR (OLD TOWN)**

Sailing in the early morning we continue towards the islet of Biševo; there is a beautiful natural phenomenon, known as Blue Cave, where you can enter on a small boat (for €10). After the morning swim in the crystal blue sea, we continue our trip to the Old town on the island of Hvar, the sunniest island in the Adriatic.

## **THURSDAY                OLD TOWN - ŠOLTA (STOMORSKA)**

After breakfast we proceed towards the beautiful island of Šolta, known for its excellent dark olive oil and lovely little fishing villages. In one of them - Stomorska – we will stay a night and have an excellent opportunity to enjoy the charms of this unique island.

## **FRIDAY                      ŠOLTA – BRAČ – SPLIT**

Our next destination is the island of Brač, i.e. the town of Bol, the typical Dalmatian fishing village turned into an attractive tourist destination. We then continue toward the famous Gold War, the most beautiful of all other town beaches in its specific shape. After bathing in both sides of the “tail”- we will sail towards Split Riviera. There we will again have an opportunity to dive into the blue sea in one of the numerous hidden bays of the Brač islands. Overnight stay in Split.

## **SATURDAY                SPLIT**
